

The work doesn't stop when a claim file is closed. Claims Associates works closely with SDPAA Members, staff, and fellow serviceproviders to leverage any lessons learned or opportunities for education or advocacy to help eliminate or mitigate future claims.

Safety Benefits Inc., (SBI) encourages SDPAA Members to take an active role in risk management and supports them in these efforts.

Loss control surveys are conducted with SDPAA Members every three years to assist Members in reducing potential liability exposures.

Property valuations are done every four years to help Members determine adequate values for property covered by SDPAA.

Managing risks and controlling losses can reduce, and in some cases eliminate, liability. Members taking an active role in reducing exposure to civil liability may earn recognition awards.

# LOSS CONTROL SERVICES

## Members Encouraged to Use Free Legal Guidance Hotlines

Two free hotlines are available for Members with questions concerning employment practices and/or civil legal issues. The hotlines are sponsored by SDPAA and coordinated by SBI.

#### **EMPLOYMENT PRACTICES HOTLINE**

Provides Members with access to attorneys specializing in employment law. In 2021, **72 Members** made a total of **180 calls**.


#### **GOVERNMENT PRACTICES HOTLINE**



## **Steady Investment Growth Continues**


